We await online numbers to find out the total attendance. The crowd spread evenly over the services. We could not have planned it better. Pastor Mary preached the sunrise service. There is something very biblical about hearing a Mary announce resurrection at sunrise. Pastor Kelsey and her team led the kids through stations in rooms downstairs, including a tomb station. Sprinkles of rain came after the sunrise service and before the egg hunt. The sun broke through the clouds during the egg hunt. Charles Davidson's *Resurrection Story* was powerful. Many people served in many ways to make the most of the weekend. Thanks to everyone who served from Friday 'til Monday. Your efforts helped others experience Resurrection Life.

Della Smith battled ALS for the past year. She died on Thursday, April 14th at the age of 81. Della was a nurse at St. Thomas.
